## **Prayers**

### **Sign of the Cross**

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

### **Glory Be (Doxology)**

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

### **Our Father (Lord's Prayer)**

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day or daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

### **Hail Mary (Ave Maria)**

### **Act of Contrition**

I firmly intend, with your help, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Savior Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In His name, my God, have mercy. Amen.

5. All Saints Day: November 1
6. Immaculate Conception of Mary: December 8

## Fasting: Limitation on Food and Drink

1. Eucharistic Fast: One hour prior to Holy Communion
2. Lent: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

## Abstinence: Refraining from Meat

1. Ash Wednesday
2. All Fridays in Lent
3. Every Friday outside unless substituted with another penance.

## Two Kinds of Sin: Original and Actual

1. Original Sin: with and in which we are born
2. Actual Sin: which we commit, either omission or commission

## Kinds of Actual Sin: Mortal and Venial

1. Mortal: death
2. Venial: does not forfeit grace.
